# What Are Integrated Admin/Operations Systems?

- Integrated admin/operations systems are designed to:
  - Educate staff in non-clinical roles of the value and priority of integrated care
  - Orient admin and operations staff to their role in supporting integrated care
  - Ensure clinical staff receive the resources and support to effectively work in an integrated care model
  - Support documentation, data collection, and reporting (e.g., Health Information Technology (HIT)



# Strategies that Support Integrated Admin/Operations



Include mental health and substance use disorder services integration in hiring, orienting, and onboarding all staff.



Ensure leadership understands and *actively* supports mental health and substance use disorder services approaches.



Ensure each department understands how they support integrated mental health and substance use disorder services.

- Finance
- Grants Management
- Human Resources
- Health Information
- Technology (HIT)
- Quality and Safety




Create opportunities for staff from different departments to discuss mental health and substance use disorder services, integrated care workflow, and service provision.



Provide ongoing education and training on mental health and substance use integrated care.









# What Are Integrated HIT Systems?

- Integrated HIT systems:
  - Facilitate clinical and non-clinical documentation, collaboration, and communication
  - Offer prompts to users for quality assurance and process improvement activities
  - Maintain and format stored data for streamlined data reporting
  - Offer enhanced reporting capabilities (e.g., customized queries and data extraction) to inform planning for future service
  - Store clinical pathways as a resource for new staff and existing staff




# Strategies that Support HIT Systems

**Technology facilitates collaboration, communication, accurate assessment, and data collection to drive quality integrated care.**

- Assess how well your electronic health record (EHR) and other platforms enhance clinical care.
- Explore how telehealth services enhance/hinder clinical care.
- Facilitate HIT and clinical staff discussion and collaboration to develop HIT solutions that streamline workflows and automate processes.
- Create documentation templates optimized for clinical data entry, quality reporting, and continuous process improvement.
- Ensure your HIT staff are oriented to mental health and integrated care and build HIT solutions with these approaches in mind.






